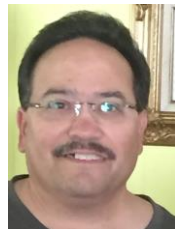

Ephesians: 6:11-18 (CEV)

Put on all the armor that God gives, so you can defend yourself against the devil's tricks. We are not fighting against humans.
